

## **Hmong Association of Washington Education Award 2015**

Established in 1983, Hmong Association of Washington (HAW) is a non-profit organization serving the Hmong community of the greater western Washington region.

### **HAW Promotes Higher Education**

HAW encourages and promotes helping Hmong students pursue their educational goals in higher education. Most Hmong students are often the first generation in their families to have the opportunity to pursue a post-secondary education.

HAW is offering three \$500 education awards to three Hmong students enrolled in an accredited college, university, technical or trade school during the 2015-2016 academic school year. Two will be awarded to first-year undergraduate students and one will be awarded to a student continuing their education of any school status.

### **Eligibility**

1. Must be a child of Hmong descent (at least one parent must be of Hmong origin)
2. Be a graduating high school senior or be currently enrolled or will be enrolling into an accredited college, university, technical or trade school with residency in the state of Washington.
3. Attend as a full-time student for the 2015-2016 academic school year (undergraduates = 12 credits/units, graduate = 9 credits/units).
4. Send in a complete application package, which includes:
  - a. Application form
  - b. A resume
  - c. Essay addressing one of the questions posed
  - d. Proof of enrollment (please provide one of the documents requested below):
    - Copy of an acceptance letter
    - A registered class schedule for the 2015 fall quarter/semester

### **Application Guidelines/Deadlines**

1. Application must be filled out completely, signed and mailed with all required attachments in order to be considered.
2. The application package must be postmarked no later than **August 28<sup>th</sup>, 2015**. **Online submissions must be received prior to 11:59pm August 28<sup>th</sup>, 2015 to be considered.**
